**Tom Warhover** is an associate professor at the Missouri School of Journalism and Editor-at-Large for the Reynolds Journalism Institute. He is chair of the University of Missouri Faculty Council on University Policy and a member of the UM System Intercampus Faculty Cabinet.

His background is in newspaper reporting and editing, and he has held leadership positions at the Virginian-Pilot, where he worked for 15 years, and the Columbia Missourian, where he was executive editor for innovation for 16 years.

He was a leader in the public (or civic) journalism movement and continues to speak out on the perils of objectivity as a journalism value. He co-authored a journalism textbook, *Getting the Whole Story: Reporting and Writing the News*. He contributes occasionally to Nieman Storyboard.
